INFORMATION to assist RLSC membership application

Why do I need to join RLSC?

RLSC is a private members Club. To conform with the RLSC's insurance policy, our RYA Instructors may only teach club members. You must be a club member **BEFORE** commencing training.

Which membership type suits me?

To get the most out of the sport you need a membership that allows you to sail at the Club. Family, Single and crew memberships are available. For individuals taking part in training we would advise you look at training or other appropriate associate membership categories (Junior, Student). All prospective members should contact the membership secretary who will advise them on the best type of membership for their personal situation.

RLSC membership definitions

(Excerpts from the RLSC Yearbook).

Full Members who shall have voting rights may be admitted at the discretion of the Committee of Management in the following categories:

Single Members who shall have attained the age of eighteen years at the date of election and shall be, or intend to be, boat owners.

***Family Members** shall include one or two adults who each shall be full members, together with their children or wards (if any) who shall not have reached the age of eighteen at the date when subscriptions fall due, or who are in full time education and not in full time employment and who shall have the status of junior members. Family members shall be, or intend to be, boat owners.

Associate Members who shall not have voting rights, may be admitted at the discretion of the Committee of Management in the following categories.

***Training Associate Membership** will be granted to people who undertake RYA certified dinghy sailing courses at the Club for the year in which the first such training is undertaken only. Such members will be able to sail and race at the Club as helms and keep a boat at the Club after payment of the boat fee.

***Junior or Student Associate Members** who shall not have reached the age of eighteen at the date when subscriptions fall due or who shall be in full time further or higher education and not be in full time employment. Junior members shall be allowed to race. All applications for membership by persons under the age of 18 years shall be accompanied by a form of indemnity signed by his/her parents or guardian as required by the Committee of Management.

Crew Associate shall be over the age of 18 on election and shall be entitled to sail as crew only, except in those races designated as crews' races and in open regattas.

Social Associate who shall be persons with an interest in the objects of the Club. Social members who wish to sail shall be treated as visitors for the purposes of sailing.

Application of membership

Every candidate for membership shall be signed by the candidate and proposed by one and seconded by another Full Member.

Applications for membership shall be in the form prescribed by the Committee of Management and shall be displayed on the notice board as required by the club rules prior to consideration by the Committee of Management.
